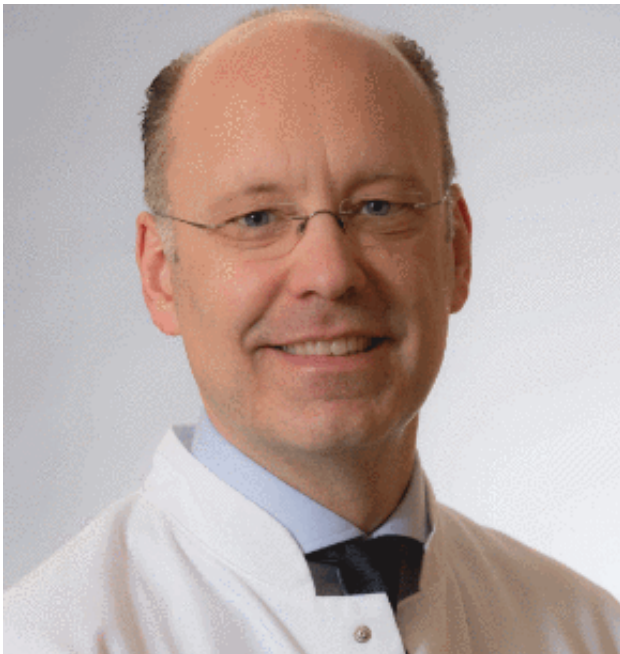
Dear Sir or Madam,

The Obesity Centre at the UKE focuses on people who are pathologically obese. A special phased concept was developed at the UKE to ensure the best possible treatment of obese patients.

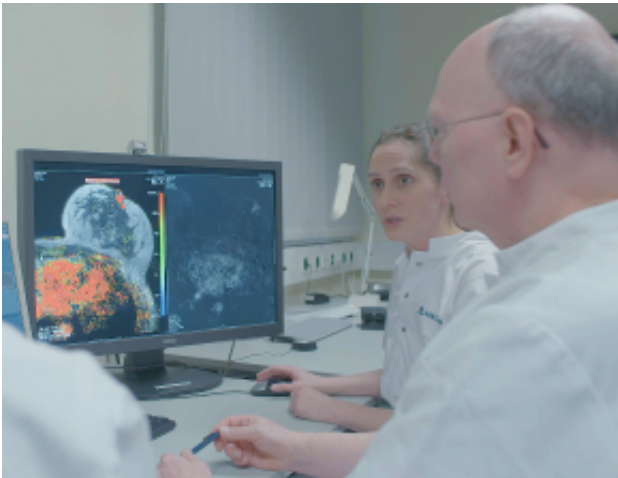
